On 28 May 2024, A Data Anomaly was observed which resulted in a deviation from the normal traffic patterns. This was due to the South African General Election taking place on the 29<sup>th</sup> of May 2024



Principal Deviation Observed: The day before a public holiday in the middle of a week will always result in lower traffic regardless of if it's in the middle of exam time

- Operational inefficiencies and technical debt
- This results in unreliable user experiences, increased operational risk, and barriers to sustainable growth or partnership.





## **Our Solution**

**Taptic combines local educational relevance with global technology discipline to deliver trusted learning platforms at scale.**

Taptic addresses these challenges by operating country-specific education platforms supported by a shared technical and governance backbone.

Key elements of the solution include

- Centralised technology governance with localised delivery
- Scalable digital platforms for academic content distribution
- Structured handling of compliance, privacy, and policy requirements per jurisdiction
- A long-term transition toward modern infrastructure, automation, and service standardisation



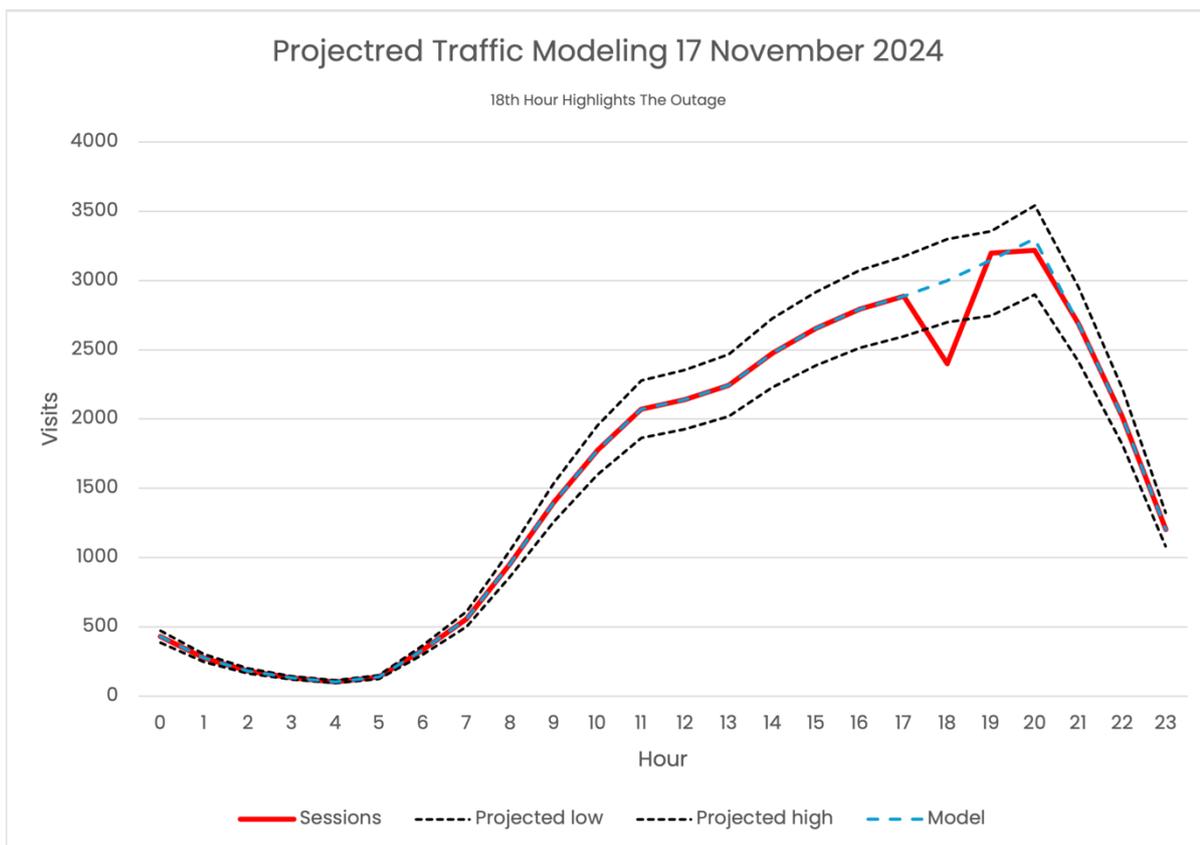


# Technology, Innovation & Product Development

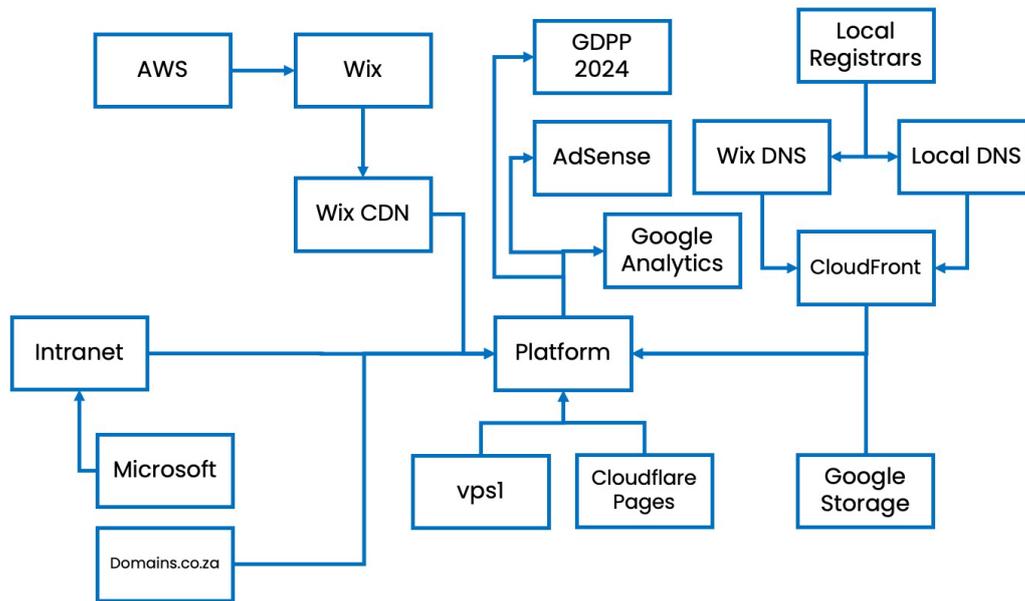
## Major Incidents

On Sunday, 17 November 2024 around 18:00 SAST, Taptic services faced a major outage affecting all platforms attributed to an internal technical limitation. While this issue was quickly corrected, it highlighted our need for the use of better technologies

## Looking Ahead: 2025 & Beyond

2025 marks a pivotal transition for Taptic. From a collection of rapidly grown education platforms into a unified, resilient, and enterprise-ready organization. The focus moving forward is not expansion for its own sake, but consolidation, standardisation, and long-term sustainability.

### Strategic Priorities

Over the next phase, Taptic will prioritise

- Platform stabilisation and modernization - Completing long-overdue technical clean-ups, redesigns, and migrations to ensure reliability, performance, and maintainability across all properties.
- Centralised governance and infrastructure control - Establishing single points of control for DNS, identity, hosting, monitoring, and compliance to reduce operational risk and enable clear oversight.
- Operational tooling and internal systems - Deploying essential internal platforms such as service desks, status pages, documentation, and workflow automation to support a growing team and partner ecosystem.
- Compliance-first expansion - Ensuring that all country platforms are aligned with local data-protection laws and a global privacy framework, enabling confident engagement with enterprise partners.
- Data-driven decision-making - Improving visibility into performance, usage, and revenue through consolidated analytics and reporting structures.

### Growth Philosophy

- Quality and reliability over speed
- Reuse of shared infrastructure across markets
- Measured, compliant expansion into new regions
- Strong alignment between product, operations, and governance

This approach ensures that scale does not come at the cost of trust, performance, or regulatory exposure.
